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NON-DESIGNATED HERITAGE ASSETS

List of non-designated Heritage Assets in the SNP designated area

1	Village Stocks and Stocks Island in the High Street
2	The Lych Gate at the top of Church Walk.
3	The pump and it's housing on Pump Island on the junction of Highworth Road and Townsend Road
4	The stone fence posts that line the grass in front of the Memorial Hall on Highworth Road
5	The canal and the slipway in the Pocket Park
6	The bridge over the canal on Stainswick Lane
7	Stepping Stones bridge on the footpath to Bourton
8	All tracks designated as Public Rights of Way which include ancient hedgerows of either side. These hedgerows are at least 500 years old.
9	Stainswick Copse ancient woodland (at least early 17 th Century)
10	Hedges on either side of Stainswick Lane which are at least 300 years old.
11	Ridge and Furrow fields at Sandhill Farm
12	Ancient hedgerows at Sandhill Farm
