Your Shrivenham Neighbourhood Plan

'Planning a better future for Shrivenham'



We now have a logo. We believe the Memorial Hall represents all that Shrivenham is – a vibrant, caring community. The word '*Shrivenham*' is yet to be inserted on the logo.

The working version of our Vision Statement is: '*Shrivenham will maintain its character as a rural village community.*'

Over the last month the Steering Group (SG) has sought advice from external agencies with a view to having professional planning experts to assist us. Meetings have involved government departments, charities and consultants. The Parish Council (PC), to whom we report, will discuss this matter at its meeting on 6th July, and arrive at a decision.

The valuable work of our own Working Groups (WGs), (Community Life, Transport and Getting Around, Environment and Design Quality, Commercial Activity, Level of Housing, Defence Academy Liaison), goes on, and they continue to meet regularly. The WGs have more members now thus a better representation of the community has been achieved. Shortly we'll visit many of the surrounding areas of our village in order to refresh our minds of the topography, geography and related factors that might be relevant in the future.

NB. It is vital that we have your involvement please. The eventual plan must be representative of the village and your thoughts and views now will help us to construct a strong and viable case.

There are several ways in which you may learn more about the SGs progress. You will be welcome at the monthly PC meetings, (1st Mondays less August), that include an agenda item. There are also the SG meetings, (last Thursday of each month), held in the Vic Day Hall.
