Section 106 and CIL Projects

Prior to the adoption of the Shrivenham NDP planning permission had already been granted for 861 homes in the village and the Section 106 money for all these developments have been allocated in agreements made between the developers, landowners and VoWHDC.

The allocations will be used for the following projects –

- Memorial Hall allocation towards upgrading and improving the facility to increase the capacity for use.
- Cricket Club allocation upgrading the cricket facilities within the parish
- Football Club allocation upgrading football facilities and towards junior pitches
- Tennis Club allocation upgrading existing facilities at the tennis club
- Sports Pavilion allocation- towards creating a new sports pavilion / clubhouse on the recreation ground to provide a home for the cricket club and indoor sports
- Indoor sports allocation towards providing indoor sports within the parish, primarily in the new sports pavilion and Memorial Hall.
- Play area allocation towards improving / increasing the play equipment / area
- Multi use games area (MUGA) allocation towards supporting improvements to the MUGA on the recreation ground;
- Art allocation towards creating art features within the parish, primarily towards contributing to entrance features at the 5 entrances to the village

During the tenure of the SNDP CIL funds are likely to be relatively low.

SDNP public engagement has identified two main areas for future expenditure should funds become available:

- The desire to develop walks, pathways and cycle ways around the village to enable leisure walks in a rural environment;
- The ongoing need to upgrade and maintain the Memorial Hall, with particular reference to sound systems, projection and lighting and storage of club equipment.
