25/130	DISTRICT COUNCILLORS' REPORT A written report had been circulated. At the meeting she reported that a) Fencing at Tuckmill Meadow was being installed. b) Concern had been raised about the state of the footbridge at Tuckmill. This had been reported to OCC. Cllr Foxhall to investigate. c) A new contract had been agreed for community services. d) Health support for Afghan families was causing concern due to some people having complex long term health care needs. e) Townsend Road – Cllr Foxhall to investigate but she believed that condition 17 had been withdrawn. f) Climate action fund grants were now available. Cllr Foxhall was thanked for attending.
